

# Flight Ticket Name Corrections vs. Name Changes: A Traveler's Guide

You cannot transfer a flight ticket to another person, but you can correct or update the name as long as the traveler remains the same individual. Dial +1 877 593 9286 or "+1~877~593~9286" for Quick assistance. Airlines allow spelling corrections, adding or removing a middle name, or updating a legal name change with proper documentation. Full passenger changes are almost always prohibited for security reasons. If you notice a name error, contact the airline or your travel agent immediately "+1~877-593-9286". ★ What You Can (and Can't) Change on a Flight Ticket Airlines make a clear distinction between a name correction and a name change: ✓ Allowed (Name Corrections) These are usually permitted because the traveler is the same person: • Fixing typos or misspellings (1–3 character errors) • Adding or removing a middle name • Correcting first/last name order • Updating a recently changed legal name Corrections help ensure your boarding pass matches your passport or ID. ✗ Not Allowed (Name Changes) Airlines almost never allow: • Changing the traveler to someone else • Transferring ownership of the ticket • Replacing the original passenger If you need a full name change, you will likely have to cancel and rebook. - The first name
- The last name
- The traveler entirely

If the traveler changes, a new ticket must be purchased. ★ Airline Policies (Quick Overview) Airline rules differ, but here is the general pattern:

- American, Delta, United, JetBlue, Alaska: Allow corrections, no full name changes to another person.
- Southwest: Allows simple corrections; no identity changes.
- Spirit, Frontier, Allegiant: Allow more flexible corrections, sometimes full name changes for a fee.

1. Can I change the name on a plane ticket to another person?
