

#### **How to Claim It**

To claim a price match, you need to find a deal that is available to the general public (not a member-only rate on another site). You will need to contact customer care immediately. Sometimes you can do this in the "My Trips" section of Priceline. If the system is locked or you cannot access the reservation, call \*\*\frac{1}{888}\$ 429-2577. An agent can manually input your frequent flyer number into the GDS record to ensure you get credit for your miles.

# **Does Priceline Charge Booking Fees? (PAA)**

Hidden fees are the enemy of budget travel.

## Flight Booking Fees

Priceline generally does not charge booking fees for standard flight tickets. You pay what the airline charges. However, there might be processing fees for complex multi-city itineraries or telephone bookings in some legacy cases.

#### **Hidden Costs**

Be aware that "Baggage Fees" and "Seat Selection Fees" are usually charged by the airline, not Priceline. Even if your Priceline receipt says "Paid," the airline might ask for \$30 for a bag at the airport. To clarify what is included in your specific ticket, a quick call to \*\*\text{1(888)} 429-2577 can save you from airport surprises.
