To find these, you need to filter your search results by "Property Type" and select "Vacation Rental" or "Guesthouse."

#### **Using Points for Hotels**

## Airline and Hotel Loyalty Integration

A massive area of confusion is loyalty status.

   bookings made through third-party sites (OTAs) like Priceline. However, your elite status
   benefits (like free WiFi) might be honored if you present your card at the front desk.
- Airline Miles: Conversely, figuring out how to get airline miles whwen book on
  Priceline is easier. You almost always earn airline miles (flown miles) on Priceline
  tickets. You just need to add your frequent flyer number at checkout or on the airline's
  site later.

- **Is Priceline a good place to book a cruise?** Actually, yes. They offer competitive onboard credits that direct cruise lines sometimes don't.
- **Is Priceline good to book cruises** for first-timers? Their search engine compares multiple lines nicely.
- Is Priceline a good way to book hotel rooms? It is their bread and butter. It is arguably what they do best.
- **Is Priceline good to book hotels** last minute? Their "Tonight-Only" deals are legendary for savings.
- Is Priceline a good company to book with overall? If you want price over flexibility, ves.
- Is Priceline ok to book with for international travel? Yes, though for complex international multi-city trips, calling +1(888) 429-2577 is recommended to ensure visa layover rules are met.

# Can You Customize Your Package? (PAA Deep Dive 1)

If you have a medical emergency, that insurance is your only way to get a refund. If you are in a crisis and need to cancel a non-refundable trip due to a death or severe illness, call +1(888) 429-2577 immediately. While they cannot promise a waiver, human agents can advocate with the airline or hotel on your behalf in ways an automated email cannot.

# **Hidden Fees and Taxes (PAA Deep Dive 4)**

People often ask, "Why did the price jump at the end?"

#### **Resort Fees**

This is the most crucial thing to understand about **how to book vacation package on Priceline**. The price you pay Priceline covers the room rate and taxes. It *rarely* covers the "Resort Fee" charged by hotels in places like Las Vegas or Miami. You pay that fee at the front desk.

#### The "Total" Cost

**Q9:** Is the app better than the website? A: The app often has "App-Only" deals that are slightly cheaper.

**Q10:** How do I get a receipt for my expense report? A: You can print your itinerary from the "My Trips" section on the website.
