While "Treehouse" isn't a specific filter yet, searching in nature-heavy destinations (like Portland or Costa Rica) and sorting by "Guest Rating" often reveals these gems.

Flight Logistics: Seats, Bags, and Boarding Passes

Now, let's talk about getting there. Knowing **how to book ticket on Priceline** is easy, but knowing **how to book travel with Priceline and select seats** requires attention to detail.

During the checkout process, not all airlines allow seat selection through third-party sites. If you see a seat map, grab your spot immediately. Note: Airlines often cap online bookings at 7-9 passengers. If you have more, you need a group desk.

Points, Payments, and Rewards Programs

However, some people ask, **is Priceline horrible to book with**? This sentiment usually comes from people who booked "Express Deals" (non-refundable) and then tried to cancel.
