

iPhone 17 Price UK: What to Expect in Pounds in 2025

Official UK Prices for iPhone 17 Models

According to official data from Apple UK and multiple trusted retailers, the 2025 iPhone 17 lineup is priced as follows (SIM-free, outright purchase unless otherwise noted):

- **iPhone 17 (standard)** — from £799 for 256 GB capacity.
- **iPhone 17 Air** — from about £999 for 256 GB.
- **iPhone 17 Pro** — from around £1,099 for 256 GB.
- **iPhone 17 Pro Max** — starting at approximately £1,199 for 256 GB. Higher storage and top-tier trims increase the price (up to premium storage options).

It's worth noting that for the base model iPhone 17, Apple has doubled the base storage compared to some older iPhones — the base now begins at 256 GB rather than 128 GB.

When and Where to Buy in the UK

The official launch of the iPhone 17 lineup in the UK was in September 2025. Pre-orders opened around mid-September, with general availability beginning later that month. You can purchase the phone through various channels:

- Directly from the official Apple Store UK (online or physical stores).

- Authorized retailers and SIM-free handset shops — often useful if you want to buy the phone without a contract.

Contract Offers and Monthly Payment Plans

If you plan to store a lot of photos, video, or apps — or keep the phone for many years — 256 GB might already be minimal. Consider stepping up to 512 GB or more if offered.
- **Compare contract deals, but watch total cost:** Monthly plans may look affordable, but when stretched over 24–36 months (common term lengths), you may end up paying as much as or more than the outright SIM-free price. Always check the total cost over the contract.
- **Wait for seasonal sales or promotions:** Around shopping events (such as Black Friday), carriers or retailers may offer discounts, trade-in bonuses, or data bundles that improve the overall value. This can make a higher-tier model more attractive for less cost.
- **Consider resale or trade-in value:** Apple and many UK carriers offer trade-in programs, which can help reduce the effective cost if you're upgrading from an older iPhone.
