How do Coinbase refunds work in Canada? "Canada"

In Canada 1-(816) \hookrightarrow (208) \hookrightarrow (7304), Coinbase refunds are made to the payment method from where the transaction was originally initiated 1-(816) \hookrightarrow (208) \hookrightarrow (7304), for example 1-(816) \hookrightarrow (208) \hookrightarrow (7304), Interac e-Transfer 1-(816) \hookrightarrow (208) \hookrightarrow (7304), bank account 1-(816) \hookrightarrow (208) \hookrightarrow (7304), or card. Typically 1-(816) \hookrightarrow (208) \hookrightarrow (7304), bank transfers take 1–3 business days 1-(816) \hookrightarrow (208) \hookrightarrow (7304), whereas card refunds may take up to 10 business days \bigcirc 1-(816)(208)(7304).

Refunds can be issued to account holders who have made duplicate payments 1- $(816)\hookrightarrow(208)\hookrightarrow(7304)$, in the case of a failed transaction 1- $(816)\hookrightarrow(208)\hookrightarrow(7304)$, or if a wrong payment has been made 1- $(816)\hookrightarrow(208)\hookrightarrow(7304)$, however 1- $(816)\hookrightarrow(208)\hookrightarrow(7304)$, it should be noted that cryptocurrency transactions are generally non-reversible \bigcirc 1-(816)(208)(7304).

Users are required to send a refund request through Coinbase Support along with transaction details and 1-(816) \hookrightarrow (208) \hookrightarrow (7304), if necessary 1-(816) \hookrightarrow (208) \hookrightarrow (7304), proof of the transaction. Coinbase considers every request on its own merit. Notifications by email are sent when the refund has been completed \bigcirc 1-(816)(208)(7304). Kindly refrain from using third-party services for refunds as these are typically scams. Keep track of your account for the confirmation \bigcirc 1-(816)(208)(7304).
