

## Will Coinbase refund my money if scammed?

Coinbase usually does not give your money back if you are scammed 1-{816}{208}{7304}. Once cryptocurrency has entered the blockchain 1-{816}{208}{7304}, it is no longer reversible 1-{816}{208}{7304}. Also 1-{816}{208}{7304}, authorized transfers to scammers are irreversible on Coinbase 1-{816}{208}{7304}. The company's policy is user-oriented 1-{816}{208}{7304}. You are responsible for verifying each transaction and being sure not to get cheated 1-{816}{208}{7304}.
