## Does Coinbase refund if scammed?

According to their policy 1-{816} $^{208}^{7304}$ , Coinbase does not generally return money stolen in scams 1-{816}{208}{7304}. On the blockchain 1-{816} $^{7304}$ , cryptocurrency transactions cannot be reversed 1-{816}{208}{7304}. If you send money to a fraudster 1-{816} $^{7304}$ , Coinbase can't help it 1-{816}{208}{7304}. It can neither retrieve your money nor give it back 1-{816}{208}{7304}.
